The General Meeting of the Cherry Valley Township Board was called to order by Supervisor Robert Shepler at 7:00pm.

Pledge of Allegiance

Present: Supervisor Robert Shepler, Treasurer Lori Jeffrey, Clerk Angie Guynn, Trustee Connie Avery, Trustee Vicki Sherman.

Minutes from the January 13, 2026, General Meeting was given to the Board, and copies were available for the attendees to review. A period of time was allowed for everyone to review them. Motion by Supervisor Robert to approve the minutes from the General Meeting and seconded by Trustee Connie. All in favor, motion carried.

Treasurer Report:

All board members received a packet from the Treasurer containing a print out of the Balance Sheet, Bank Statements for both the General Fund and the Tax Account along with Reconciliation detail for both. Copies were available to the public to review. Treasurer Lori explained the accounts and asked if there were any comments. None being said, a Motion was made by Supervisor Robert and seconded by Clerk Angie. Motion carried.

Motioned by Supervisor Robert and seconded by Trustee Vicki to approve payment of outstanding bills. All in favor, motion carried.

Supervisor Report

Clerk Report:

Old Business:

Parking lot sealant: Supervisor Robert will be collecting bids for oil-based sealcoating the township parking lot.

Cemetery: Supervisor Robert will be collecting bids for clearing and cleaning the cemetery. No headstones or other property damage occurred.

New Business:

Treasurer Lori, advised the board that will continue to use Allpaid for taxes.

Treasurer Lori presented the contract for the road brine this season. Lori motioned to accept the contract, Trustee Connie second; all in favor, motion carried. Treasurer Lori to provide copies of the contract at our next meeting.

Treasurer Lori presented the MTA's Principles of Governance for Cherry Valley Township. Treasurer Lori motioned to accept the Principles of Governance, Trustee Connie second, all in favor, motion carried.

Treasurer Lori presented the need of internet at the township hall. Spectrum internet will be available this year. Treasurer Lori motioned to have internet at the township hall, Trustee Vickie second, all in favor, motion carried.

Treasurer Lori advised the board that Cherry Valley Township is hosting the next Township Officers Association meeting, on April 23, 2026 at 6pm.

Guest Speaker/Public Comments:

Board of Review member, Dawn Shepler, presented the tax review cases they reviewed: 4 petitions were submitted, 2 poverty exemptions were approved and one will be coming to the next meeting.
